On February 14, 1996, approximately 50 parents gathered for a Valentine's Day dinner fundraiser to benefit Hermosa Beach schools. **Hearts of Hermosa**, as it was called, was the beginning of what became our Hermosa Beach Education Foundation. This dedicated group of parents and community members recognized the need to address the funding gap in our schools and ignited a passion in this community for a strong public school district.

That mission is as important today as it was then: The best investment we can make is in our children's education.


